Husky Energy, on behalf of the West White Rose Project (WWRP) proponents, Husky, Suncor Energy Inc. (Suncor) and Nalcor Energy – Oil and Gas Inc. (Nalcor), is leading the development of the WWRP. The White Rose field and satellite extensions are located in the Jeanne d’Arc Basin, 350 km east of Newfoundland and Labrador in approximately 120 m of water.

The West White Rose Project will be developed through a fixed drilling platform consisting of a concrete gravity structure (CGS), and an integrated topsides facility, which includes the Living Quarters (LQ) module. The LQ module will be constructed at the Kiewit Offshore Services (Kiewit) facility, located in Marystown, approximately 300 km from St. John’s, NL.

Kiewit, in relation to the Living Quarters module construction, hereby invites interested parties to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) and a completed Prequalification Questionnaire for the **Provision of Intumescent Passive Fire Protection Coating System Materials**.

General Requirements

Respondents to the EOI and prequalification must be qualified to conduct the scope as outlined in the Scope of Work below. They are required to demonstrate their capabilities and experiences via a formal response to this EOI/ Prequalification advertisement. The Prequalification Questionnaire, which can be downloaded at this website: <https://wwrplivingquarters.com/procurement/>, is largely based on Kiewit’s Supplier Management System and contains detailed questions regarding your company’s technical,

quality, health, safety, environment and commercial capabilities. Respondents who are successfully prequalified and are invited to participate in any Request for Proposal (RFP) process, will also be required to formally register with Ariba (Kiewit's supplier registration website), details of which will be provided later.

Scope of Work

Respondents shall provide, as requested, offshore Intumescent Passive Fire Protection Coating System materials in accordance with the project specifications for the Husky Energy WWRP, with an approximate surface area of 800m². As part of the EOI submission, KOS requires the Supplier's to document a minimum of 15 years product experience on installations in the North Atlantic Offshore environment.

For this project, the supplier will be required to stock an inventory of all supplied coating material at a warehouse in province. All material shall be recently batched and free of damage upon arrival at the Kiewit Offshore Services Fabrication Facility. Respondent shall be responsible for packaging and shipping material to site.

Additionally, the Supplier will be required to provide applicator training on site in Marystown for our painting personnel.

Finally technical support will be required and the supplier should provide the location / contacts for this technical support.
